



Dear Friends of PARKER,

I am asking for your help since no doubt you've personally experienced or heard about PARKER's extraordinary care over the years. So that you and future generations can have access to PARKER's high quality, affordable long-term care when needed, we want to continue to grow our services.

Plans are underway for PARKER at Monroe, future home for 96 residents who need skilled nursing care and 32 assisted-living residents who require memory support. PARKER is seeking approval from the Monroe Township Planning Board and there is no question about the tremendous and growing need for PARKER at Monroe.

Despite the fact that the proposed site on Schoolhouse Road is zoned for such use, our plan is facing strong resistance from some local residents who are voicing concerns about overdevelopment and local traffic. While we are taking these concerns seriously, I struggle with the implication that the many seniors who need long term care are not welcomed as residents in a residential neighborhood.

As you know, PARKER always is a strong environmental steward. The graciously-landscaped village-style homes will sit quietly on the naturally-wooded site and be set back from the main road. More than half of the 28 acre site will be donated as preserved open space. Few proposed developments include such a strong commitment to maintaining open space and natural beauty. Also, we are working proactively with Monroe officials to ensure local traffic patterns are not affected.

I am asking your help, as we are seeking to serve you, our loyal PARKER Registry waitlist members who may need PARKER's services in the future.
